


This is the last Schneeberg edging for now. Maybe we do more Schneeberg laces later. We don't know yet. Because Christmas is coming, I designed together with my husband an edging with angels. When you take a good look at the 2 little angels, you will see that they are not completely the same. These are "designer problems". The edging and the fillings are drawn and when you start making the lace, you find out that some plaits stop. Of course you can insert them in the tape for a while. A little angel with hair or cap in another color is ok, but the same at the elbows? No, that is not good. In the second angel you will see that I found a way to continue that plait through the tape.

For this edging you will need 12 pairs of bobbins with DMC fil a dentelle 80 of similar





There are no real difficulties in this edging only the 6 pairs crossing in the centre of the big angel. See for the drawings below how to make it.



Have fun with this edging. Next week we start with another lace type and a more simple edging or insertion. Then also the less experienced lacers can join in again.
